REGULATIONS

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister of Works and Infrastructure under section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (GEORGE EARL PARK, ST. JOSEPH) REGULATIONS, 2014

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) (George Earl Park, St. Joseph) Regulations, 2014.
- 2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 17th November, Duration 2014 and expire on Monday 16th February, 2015.
 - 3. A motorist shall not park his motor vehicle on the—

Parking

- (a) northern side of Richmond Street, between Abercromby prohibited Street and Piccadilly Street;
- (b) northern side of Albert Street, between Abercromby Street and Piccadilly Street; and
- (c) western side of Piccadilly Street, from its intersection with Albert Street to a marked point twenty metres south,

Monday to Friday, except on public and school holidays.

4. A motorist shall proceed in—

One-way

- (a) an easterly direction only on Richmond Street, between Abercromby Street and Piccadilly Street, from 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, except on public and school holidays;
- (b) a northerly direction only on Piccadilly Street, between Richmond Street and Savary Street, from 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, except on public and school holidays; and
- (c) an easterly direction on Albert Street, between Abercromby Street and Piccadilly Street, from 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, except on public and school holidays.

Offence and penalty

5. A person who contravenes these Regulations commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
