# REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

#### REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

## THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (PORT-OF-SPAIN/WOODBROOK/ST. JAMES) REGULATIONS, 2014

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) (Port-of-Spain/Woodbrook/St. James) Regulations, 2014.

2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 22nd December, Duration 2014 and expire on Saturday 21st March, 2015.

## PART I

### PORT-OF-SPAIN

3. A driver shall proceed in an easterly direction only on Hart One-way Street, between St. Vincent Street and Abercromby Street.

4. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the southern Parking side of Duke Street, between St. Vincent Street and Edward Street from <sup>prohibited</sup> a point nine metres west of St. Vincent Street and extending to a point forty-nine metres westward, as marked, Monday to Friday, except for persons driving official motor vehicles of the Maritime Services Division, Ministry of Transport.

### PART II

#### WOODBROOK

5. (1) A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the  ${\rm Parking}_{\rm prohibited}$ 

- (a) Gallus Street;
- (b) Alberto Street;
- (c) Rosalino Street;
- (d) Murray Street; or
- (e) Fitt Street,

between Ariapita Avenue and Wrightson Road on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, except on public holidays.  $(2)\ A$  person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the western side of—

- (a) Gallus Street;
- (b) Alberto Street;
- (c) Rosalino Street;
- (d) Murray Street; or
- (e) Fitt Street,

between Ariapita Avenue and Wrightson Road on Tuesday and Thursday, except on public holidays.

## PART III

# St. James

Parking 6. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the western side of Clarence Street.

Offence and penalty 7. A person who contravenes regulation 3, 4, 5 or 6 commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and imponding of vehicles unlawfully parked 8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
