## **ORDER**

Made by the Minister of Works and Infrastructure under section 65 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

## THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (MARAVAL/ST. JAMES) ORDER, 2014

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Maraval/Citation St. James) Order, 2014.
- 2. A person driving a motor vehicle may proceed in an easterly and Two-way westerly direction on Rapsey Street, between Wainwright Street and traffic Saddle Road between the hours of 6.30 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. Monday to Friday except on a public holiday.
- 3. A person driving a motor vehicle proceeding east on Rapsey No left turn Street shall not turn left onto Saddle Road between the hours of 6.30 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. Monday to Friday except on a public holiday.
- 4. Between the hours of 6.30 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. Monday to Friday one-way except on a public holiday, a person driving a motor vehicle shall <sup>traffic</sup> proceed in—
  - (a) a south-easterly direction only on Saddle Road, from Long Circular Road to Rapsey Street;
  - (b) an easterly direction only on Patna Street, between Agra Street and Long Circular Road;
  - (c) a northerly direction only on Bengal Street, between Patna Street and Delhi Street;
  - (d) a southerly direction only on Long Circular Road, between Patna Street and Delhi Street; and
  - (e) a westerly direction only on Delhi Street, between Long Circular Road and Calcutta Street.
- 5. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order Offence and commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of penalty three thousand dollars or to imprisonment for three months.
