REGULATIONS

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister of Works and Transport under section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (WOODBROOK) REGULATIONS, 2016

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) (Woodbrook) Regulations, 2016.
- 2. These Regulations come into operation on Monday 29th August, Duration 2016 and expire on Monday 28th November, 2016.
- 3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a southerly one-way direction only on Stone Street, between Park Street and Flament ^{traffic} Street.
- 4. A person driving a motor vehicle and proceeding in a westerly No "U" turn direction on Park Street, shall not make a "U" turn onto the eastbound lane of Park Street, in the vicinity of Stone Street.
 - 5. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the—

 (a) northern side of Park Street, between Stone Street and Scott-Bushe Street; and
 - (b) southern side of Duke Street, between Victoria Square West and Victoria Square East.
- 6. A person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on Offence and summary conviction, in the case of a first offence, to a fine of seven penalty hundred and fifty dollars and in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine of one thousand dollars.
- 7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in impounding contravention of these Regulations may be removed by a member of the unlawfully Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with parked section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
