Description: The proposed 355.60 mm (14.00 in) diameter multiphase pipeline will begin at the high-water mark at a point north of the Point Lisas Industrial Estate and proceed in a southeasterly direction for approximately 1.24 km (0.77 mi) to a proposed Gas Processing Unit across from Point Lisas Nitrogen Limited. See Reference Map "A".

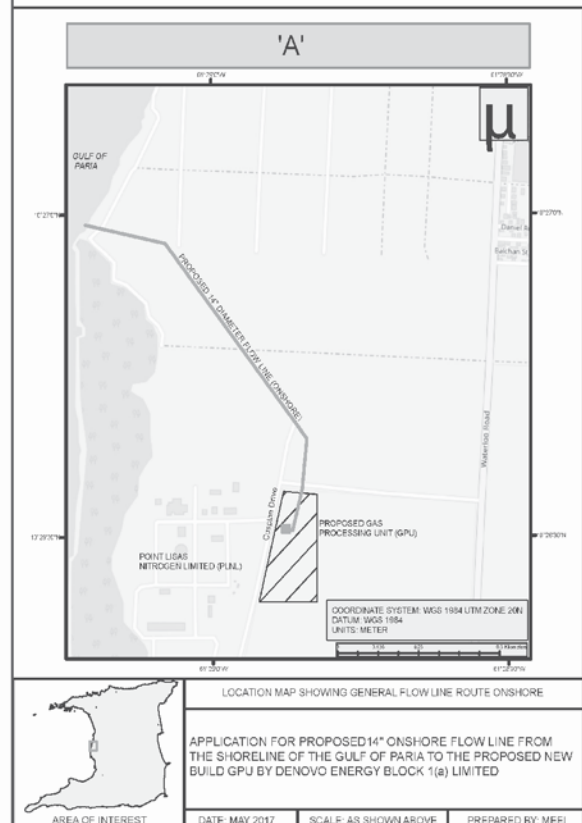
