#### FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1999 CHAPTER 22:02 (FOIA)

In compliance with Sections 7, 8 and 9 of the Freedom of Information Act, 1999 (FOIA).

In accordance with Sections 7, 8 and 9 of the Freedom of Information Act, 1999 (FOIA) the Trinidad and Tobago Securities & Exchange Commission ("the Commission") is required by law to publish the following statements, which list the documents and information generally available for public scrutiny.

#### The FOIA gives members of the public a legal right:

- (1) For each person to access information held by the Commission;
- (2) For each person to have official information relating to himself/ herself amended where it is incomplete, incorrect or misleading;
- (3) To obtain reasons for adverse decisions made by the Commission regarding an applicant's request for information under the FOIA;
- (4) To complain to the Ombudsman and to apply to the High Court for judicial review to challenge adverse decisions made under the FOIA.

#### **Functions and Organisation of the Commission**

#### Mission

To protect investors, promote and enable the growth and development of the securities industry by nurturing fair, efficient and transparent securities markets, cooperating with other regulators and mitigating systemic risk.

#### **Functions of the Commission**

The Commission was first established, by the Securities Industry Act, 1995 (SIA 1995) in 1997 and continued under the Securities Act, 2012 (SA 2012) as a body corporate to regulate the securities market in Trinidad and Tobago.

The Commission's main functions, as outlined in Section 6 of the SA 2012 are to:

- Advise the Minister of Finance on matters relating to the securities industry;
- Maintain surveillance over the securities industry and ensure orderly, fair and equitable dealings in securities;
- Register, authorize or regulate, in accordance with the SA 2012, self-regulatory organizations, broker-dealers, registered representatives, traders, underwriters, issuers and investment advisers and control and supervise their activities with a view to maintaining proper standards of conduct, and professionalism in the securities industry;
- Regulate and supervise the timely, accurate, fair and efficient disclosure of information to the securities industry and investing public;
- Conduct such inspections, reviews and examinations of self-regulatory organizations, brokerdealers, registered representatives, underwriters, issuers and investment advisers as may be necessary for giving full effect to the SA 2012;
- Protect the integrity of the securities industry against any abuses arising from market manipulating practices, insider trading, conflicts of interest, and other unfair or improper practices;
- Educate and promote an understanding by the public of the securities industry and the benefits, risks, and liabilities associated with investing in securities;
- Co-operate with and provide assistance to other regulatory authorities in Trinidad and Tobago, or elsewhere:
- Ensure compliance with the Proceeds of Crime Act, any other written law in relation to the
  prevention of money laundering and combating the financing of terrorism or any other written
  law that is administered or supervised by the Commission;
- Create and promote such conditions in the securities industry as may seem to it necessary, advisable or appropriate to ensure the orderly growth and development of the securities industry and to further the purposes of the SA 2012;
- Co-operate with other jurisdictions in the development of a fair and efficient securities industry; and
- Assess, measure and evaluate risk exposure in the securities industry.

### PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION 2017—Continued

#### Powers of the Commission

For the purpose of the discharge of its functions, the Commission has power pursuant to Section 7 of the SA 2012 to, amongst other things:

- (a) Register and regulate market actors in accordance with the SA 2012;
- (b) Formulate principles for the guidance of the securities industry;
- (c) Take enforcement action against any person for failing to comply with the SA 2012;
- (d) Do all things and take all actions, which may be necessary, expedient, incidental or conducive to the discharge of any of its functions and the exercise of its powers under the SA 2012.

#### Structure of the Commission

The SA 2012 provides for the appointment of no less than five and no more than nine Commissioners to the Board of the Commission.

The Commissioners are drawn from amongst persons with expertise in legal, financial, business or administrative matters. One of these persons must be an Attorney-at-Law of at least 10 years standing.

#### Staff of the Commission

The Staff is appointed by the Commission and includes the Chief Executive Officer, Deputy Chief Executive Officer, General Counsel/Corporate Secretary, the Heads of the existing Divisions and support staff.

1. THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO ("GORTT"), by way of the Finance Act, 2012, amended the Corporation Tax Act, Chap 75:02 in 2014 in response to feedback from the Small and Medium Market Enterprise ("SME") Sector;

#### **AND WHEREAS:**

- 2. By correspondence dated August 19, 2016, the Trinidad and Tobago Stock Exchange ("TTSE") submitted a Statement of Substance and Purpose to the Commission requesting an Order to amend its SME Market Listing Requirements;
- 3. The TTSE has indicated that the proposed amendments to requirements 7 and 8 of its SME Market Listing Requirements have become necessary in order to bring its SME Market Listing Requirements in line with the changes to the Corporation Tax Act, Chap 75:02 (by way of the Finance Act 2014). These amendments and the relevant sections of the Corporation Tax Act, Chap 75:02 are outlined in the Appendix hereto;
- 4. The TTSE is required to ensure that its rules and regulations are in conformity with substantive legislation at all times and as such, the proposed amendments have been determined to fall within the remit of S. 40(6)(b) of the Securities Act 2012.

#### AND UPON:

- 5. The Board of Commissioners approving the proposed amendments to the Trinidad and Tobago Stock Exchange Limited's Small and Medium Enterprise Market Listing Requirements;
- 6. The Board of Commissioners determining that in accordance with Section 159(10) of the Act the making of this Order does not require a hearing pursuant to Section 159(1) of the Act.

#### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

I. The proposed amendments to the Trinidad and Tobago Stock Exchange Limited's Small and Medium Enterprise Market Listing Requirements are approved;

#### **APPENDIX**

#### **Corporation Tax Amendment**

The 2014 amendment of the Corporation Tax Act Section 3 subsections 2 and 3, as it relates to the SME market is as follows:

In the case of a SME listed company, the rate of tax shall be ten per cent for the first five years from listing on the Trinidad and Tobago Stock Exchange and thereafter at the rate of tax specified in paragraph 1 of the First Schedule where –

- (a) a minimum of twenty-five unconnected shareholders own a total of at least thirty per cent of the new issued share capital of the company; and
- (b) capital is raised with the issuance of an initial public offering to be followed by a listing on the Trinidad and Tobago Stock Exchange no more than sixty days after allotment of the issue.

In subsection (s), "SME listed company" means a Small and Medium Enterprise company listed on the Trinidad and Tobago Stock Exchange, namely a company whose-

- (a) minimum issued share capital is five million dollars and a maximum issued share capital does not exceed fifty million dollars following the initial public offering;
- (b) minimum and maximum capital base comprises of issued share capital only and does not include retained earnings and accounts transferred from such issued share capital or retained earnings to a reserved account; and
- (c) minimum number of unconnected shareholders is twenty-five.

#### Proposed Amendments to the SME Listing Requirements

#### **Public Distribution**

Following the initial public offering, the issuer must have a minimum of 25 unconnected shareholders holding at least 30% of the new issued share capital of the company. In this instance, "new and issued share capital" is interpreted as, the SME adding new shares to its existing issued share capital, where 30% of these new shares must be held by a minimum of 25 unconnected shareholders. For the purpose of this requirement, an unconnected shareholder means a person who is not connected to the reporting issuer. A definition for a person connected to a reporting issuer is outlined in Section 4(3) of the Securities Act 2012.

#### **Capital Base**

The issuer must have a minimum issued share capital of TT\$5,000,000.00 and the maximum issued share capital must not exceed TT\$50,000,000.00 following the initial public offering. The minimum and maximum capital base comprises of issued share capital only and does not include retained earnings and accounts transferred from such issued share capital or retained earnings to a reserved account.



The Architecture Profession Act No.19 of 1992 is an Act that governs the profession of architecture in Trinidad and Tobago. In order to protect the public interest, the Act establishes the Board of Architecture of Trinidad and Tobago (BoATT), which assesses the qualifications and experience of any person applying to become a Registered Architect, a title protected under the Act.

**Prohibitions**Section 16 of The Architecture Profession Act, 1992

- 16. A person who is not a registered architect shall not -
- (a) use any title or description that leads to the belief that he is a registered architect;
- (c) act in a manner so as to create or induce the belief that he is a registered architect:
- (d) sign or stamp any plans, drawings, designs, or specifications, purporting to be acting in the capacity of such registered architect.
