Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (a) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender;
- (b) A Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original and three (3) copies of the Tender should be placed in sealed envelopes, addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and clearly marked on the outside: "Tender for Refurbishing and Repaying Works at the Night Soil (Dog Pound) Compound for the Port-of-Spain Corporation, Ministry of Rural Development and Local Government".
