A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the Land Regulations published in the *Gazette* on 10th January, 1918, were made by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago as Intendant of Crown Lands:

And whereas it is provided *inter alia*, by regulation 18 of the said Land Regulations, that the Governor may from time to time by proclamation in the *Royal Gazette* declare any area of Crown Land described in such proclamation to be a Forest Reserve:

And whereas the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago by Proclamation No. 8 dated 2nd February, 1922, declared the area of Crown Land comprising 2.86 square miles, more or less, situate in the Ward of Arima, in the County of St. George, known as the "Arima Reserve", as a Forest Reserve (hereinafter referred to as "the Arima Forest Reserve"):

And whereas it is provided by section 4 of the State Lands Act, Chap. 57:01, *inter alia*, that the said Land Regulations and all Proclamations and Orders made thereunder shall have effect as if they were made by the President: And whereas it is provided by section 45(1) of the Interpretation Act, Chap. 3:01, that where a written law confers a power to make any statutory instrument, the power shall be construed as including power exercisable in the like manner and subject to the like consent and conditions, if any, to amend, alter, rescind or revoke that instrument and to make other statutory instruments in lieu thereof:


And whereas it is now expedient that the parcel of State land described in the Schedule and situate at 1¼ Mile Mark, Blanchisseuse Road, in the Ward of Arima, in the County of St. George, no longer form part of the Arima Forest Reserve:

Now, therefore, I, ANTHONY THOMAS AQUINAS CARMONA, O.R.T.T., S.C., President as aforesaid, do hereby declare that the parcel of State land described in the Schedule and situate at 1¹/₄ Mile Mark, Blanchisseuse Road, in the Ward of Arima, in the County of St. George, no longer form part of the Arima Forest Reserve.

SCHEDULE

A parcel of land comprising approximately 10.1169 hectares or 25 acres, more or less, situate at 1¹/₄ Mile Mark, Blanchisseuse Road, bounded on the north by State lands, on the south and west by lands of Mausica Estate and on the east by lands belonging to the People of Praise and an access road 10.00 metres wide, which parcel of land is delineated and coloured pink on Survey Order No. 8/2013 annexed hereto.
