ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (CADIZ ROAD, BELMONT AND FONDES DE AMANDES ROAD, ST. ANN'S) ORDER, 2017

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Cadiz Road, Citation Belmont and Fondes de Amandes Road, St. Ann's) Order, 2017.

2. This Order shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Commencement Monday 5th June, 2017.

3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park the motor vehicle $N_0 \mbox{ parking on} - -$

- (a) the northern side of Cadiz Road, from its intersection with Queen's Park East to a point thirty-three metres east of the said intersection; and
- (b) Fondes de Amandes Road, from its intersection with St. Ann's Road to a point one hundred and nine metres north of the said intersection.

4. Any person who contravenes this Order commits an offence and Offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of three thousand dollars or to ^{penalty} imprisonment for three months.

5. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in $\frac{\text{impounding of}}{\text{vehicles}}$ contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and $\frac{\text{unlawfully}}{\text{unlawfully}}$ impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the $\frac{\text{parked}}{\text{Motor Vehicles}}$ Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
