ORDER

Made by the Minister under section 34A(1) of the Brewery Act

THE BREWERY (MANUFACTURE OF BEVERAGES) ORDER, 2017

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Brewery (Manufacture of Citation Beverages) Order, 2017.
- 2. In this Order, "Company" means the Samba Brewing Company Interpretation and Winery.
- 3. (1) The Minister authorizes the Company to manufacture the Authority to following products subject to the terms and conditions in subclause (2): manufacture heverages
 - (a) Cara Mia Wine [(3 l) 11% of alcohol];
 - (b) Tropical Escape [(275 ml) 5% of alcohol];
 - (c) 10 Saints Beer [(275 ml) 4.8% of alcohol];
 - (d) 10 Saints Beer [(330 ml) 4.8% of alcohol];
 - (e) 560 Light Beer [(275 ml) 4.8% of alcohol];
 - (f) Nutra Malt [(207 ml) non-alcoholic];
 - (g) Nutra Malt [(275 ml) non-alcoholic];
 - (h) Xtra Malt Empower [(275 ml) non-alcoholic];
 - (i) Malta Suprema [(207 ml) non-alcoholic];
 - (j) Malta Migente [(207 ml) non-alcoholic]; and
 - (k) Malta Caracas {(207 ml) non-alcoholic].
- (2) In manufacturing the beverages referred to in subclause (1), the Company shall comply with the following terms and conditions:
 - (a) the manufacturing process shall be submitted to the Brewery Officer;
 - (b) twenty-four hours advance notice shall be submitted to the Brewery Officer prior to the commencement of the manufacturing process;
 - (c) the dissolving and collecting vessels shall be clearly identified;

- (d) the Company shall keep a register and that register shall show particulars pertaining to the quantity and description of—
 - (i) raw materials received;
 - (ii) raw materials issued for the manufacturing process; and
 - (iii) the finished product after bottling; and
- (e) all operations shall be subject to the Brewery Officer's supervision.
