MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

## THE TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER, 2017

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control Order, 2017. Citation

2. This Order shall take effect on Monday 3rd July, 2017. Commencement

## PART I

## St. Joseph

- 3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right from— No right turn
  - (a) Eastern Main Road, onto Agostini Street, Monday to Friday from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m., except on public holidays; and
  - (b) Hutton Street, onto the eastern Main Road, Monday to Friday from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m., except on public holidays.
- 4. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a-One-way traffic
  - (a) southerly direction on Agostini Street, Monday to Friday from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m., except on public holidays; and
  - (b) northerly direction on Agostini Street, Monday to Friday from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., except on public holidays.

## PART II

#### TUNAPUNA

- 5. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on-Parking
  - prohibited
  - (a) Auzonville Road from Monday to Saturday, except on public holidays;
  - (b) Cochrane Street from Monday to Saturday, except on public holidays;
  - (c) the eastern side of Morton Street on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, except on public holidays;

- (d) the western side of Morton Street on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, except on public holidays;

No right turn 10. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right from Chan Ramlal Road onto Endeavour Road.

Parking 11. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on 2nd Avenue.

### PART V

## VALSAYN

12. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a westerly <sub>One-way</sub> direction only on Grove Road from Queen Elizabeth Avenue to Prince <sup>traffic</sup> Charles Avenue, between the hours of 4.00 p.m. and 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

  - (g) the western side of Quenca Street, between St. James Street and Chacon Street; and
  - (h) the eastern side of Todd Street, between Westwood Street and Rushworth Street.
- 22. A driver of a taxi or maxi-taxi shall not proceed—

No entry to taxis and

- (a) west onto Bamboo Bay Road, Bamboo Drive, at its maxi-taxis intersection with Gulf View Drive, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays;
- (b) south onto Nairn Avenue at its intersection with Naparima-Mayaro Road, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays;
- (c) south onto Simpson Brown Terrace at its intersection with Naparima-Mayaro Road, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays; and

Taxi stand

- (d) west onto Forres Avenue at its intersection with Naparima-Mayaro Road, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.
- Maxi-taxi 23. A person plying a maxi-taxi for hire along the San Fernando/Princes Town route shall ply on the southern side of Coffee Street, between Johnstone Street and Prince of Wales Street, with a maximum of nine maxi-taxis facing west, as marked.

Maxi-taxi 24. (1) A person driving a maxi-taxi, plying the entry and exit San Fernando/Princes Town route shall exit Coffee Street by turning right only onto Carib Street.

(2) A person plying a maxi-taxi for hire shall have access to all streets in San Fernando between the hours of 6.00 p.m. and 5.00 a.m. only.

# PART VII

## MARABELLA

One-way traffic 25. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in—

- (a) a northerly direction only on 5th Avenue, Maraj Lands, between Southern Main Road and 4th Avenue, Maraj Lands, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays; and
- (b) an easterly direction only on 1st Avenue, Maraj Lands, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

No parking

- 26. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the—
  - (a) eastern side of Maraj Avenue, on Tuesdays and Thursdays, except on public holidays; and
  - (b) western side of Maraj Avenue, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, except on public holidays.

## PART VIII

### Couva

One-way traffic 27. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a northerly direction only on Hosein Street, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., except on public holidays.

## PART IX

#### BALMAIN

28. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed along—

- (a) Manse Street, between Williams Street and the entrance to the Balmain Presbyterian School, in a westerly direction only; and
- (b) Williams Street, between Manse Street and the Balmain Main Road, in a northerly direction only, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., except on public holidays.

## PART X

#### ST. AUGUSTINE

29. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the northern  $_{No parking}$  and southern sides of Orange Grove Road, St. Augustine, between Streatham Lodge Road and College Road, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., except on public holidays.

### PART XI

## Arima

30. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the—

No parking

- (a) western side of De Graff Street, between Pro De Verteuil Street and Cocorite Road on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays; and
- (b) eastern side of De Graff Street, between Pro De Verteuil Street and Cocorite Road on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

31. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed along De Graff One-way Street, between Pro De Verteuil Street and Cocorite Road, in a <sup>traffic</sup> southerly direction only.

## PART XII

### BARATARIA

32. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a westerly <sub>One-way</sub> direction only on Eighth Street, between Sixth Avenue and Seventh <sup>traffic</sup> Avenue, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m., and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., on Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

## GASPARILLO

No right turn 33. A person driving a motor vehicle proceeding in an easterly direction along Bonne Aventure Road shall not turn right at its intersection with Harmony Hall Road, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

One-way traffic

- 34. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed—

- (b) road commonly referred to as the Zoo Road, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6 p.m.; and

38. A person driving a motor vehicle along Lum Track Hill shall One-way proceed in a southerly direction only from—

- (a) the main entrance of the Fyzabad Presbyterian School to Fyzabad-Guapo Road; and
- (b) Fyzabad-Oropouche Road to the main entrance of the Fyzabad Presbyterian School, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

#### PART XVIII

### ST. JAMES

39. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the eastern  $N_0$  parking side of Vidale Street.

#### PART XIX

#### TAROUBA

40. A bus owned and operated by the Public Transport Service Right turn to Corporation proceeding in a southerly direction along the Sir Solomon Public Transport Hochoy Highway may exit the Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway at Ramp 1 Service of the Torouba Interchange and may turn right at the intersection of Corporation Ramp 1 and the Tarouba Link Road, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to <sup>buses only</sup> 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

## PART XX

# General

Offence and penalty

41. A person who contravenes this order commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of three thousand dollars or imprisonment for three months.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:50

42. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
