Act No. 3 of 2018

An Act to supplement and vary the appropriation of the sum the issue of which was authorized by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2018) Act, 2017

[Assented to 21st May, 2018]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Short title (Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation) (Financial Year 2018) Act, 2018.

Further issue of \$213,000,000 from the Consolidated Fund No. 3

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of two hundred and thirteen million dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending September 30, 2018 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Act.

3. The sums appropriated by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2018) Act, 2017 to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

4. The sum appropriated by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2018) Act, 2017 to the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule is reduced by the amount specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Sums appropriated in respect of Head specified in Part II of the Schedule may be utilized

5. The sum appropriated by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2018) Act, 2017 in respect of the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule and not utilised at the commencement of this Act, may be utilized, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule.
