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INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—January, 2018 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

The following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of January, 2018 was 107.0, representing a decrease of 0.1 point or 0.1% below the All Items Index for December, 2017.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January, 2018 over the period January, 2017 was 0.8%. This rate is less than that observed for the period January, 2017 over the period January, 2016, which was 3.6%.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 116.0 in December, 2017 to 115.4 in January, 2018, reflecting a decrease of 0.5%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of fresh whole chickens, tomatoes, chive, fresh duck, frozen whole chickens, hot peppers, celery, oranges, lettuce and mixed fresh seasoning. However, the full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general increase in the prices of fresh carite, table margarine, parboiled rice, powdered full cream milk, pimento, cocoa and chocolate based preparations (beverage), irish potatoes, eddoes, corn curls, cheese balls, tortilla chips, etc. (snacks) and peas and carrots.

Price changes in this section for the month of January, 2018 accounted for a net overall decrease of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for January, 2018, compared with December, 2017, reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.4%, Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels of 0.4%, Transport of 0.3%, Recreation and Culture of 0.6% and Hotels, Cafes and Restaurants of 1.1%. However decreases were noted in the sub indicies for Clothing and Footwear of 1.2%, Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Maintenance of the House of 0.9%, Health of 0.4% and Communication of 0.1%. All other sections remained unchanged.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of January, 2018, had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.
