SUPREME COURT OF JUDICATURE OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

PRACTICE GUIDE

COURTPAY SYSTEM FOR THE PAYMENT IN AND OUT OF COURT OF MAINTENANCE PAYMENTS

WHEREAS the Court may order maintenance payments be paid into Court for the benefit of recipients, minor children or dependents;

AND WHEREAS it is essential that a more efficient, timely, secure and convenient method for receiving and paying Court-ordered maintenance be made available to parties in court matters;

AND WHEREAS the Judiciary has provided a system known as CourtPay in keeping with the above;

It has become necessary to issue this Practice Guide to provide guidelines for the drafting of maintenance orders to facilitate the proper use of CourtPay.

Application of the Practice Direction

These Directions apply to all matters in which the Court has ordered that Maintenance Payments be paid into Court.

Definitions

In this Practice Direction-

"CourtPay" is the Judiciary's software system which manages the information in relation to payments made into the Judiciary's custodial bank account using Cash (through a Top-up card); Credit Card; or Standing Order; and out of the Judiciary's Custodial Bank account into the recipient's bank account or to the recipient in cash.

"Custodial Account" means the bank account at a commercial bank opened in the name of the Judiciary of Trinidad and Tobago Court Ordered Maintenance for the purpose of receiving and paying out maintenance funds in accordance with court orders which provide for this and which provides financial reports to the court through the CourtPay system.

Transaction Fee

When submitting a payment using the CourtPay system, the payor is charged a small nonrefundable transaction fee for each transaction submitted. The requirement to pay this transaction fee should form part of the maintenance order.

Usual costs associated with use of credit card, linx or standing order

The payor will be responsible for the usual costs associated with any of the payment methods the payor chooses to use.

Guidelines for the Drafting of Orders for Maintenance when monies are to be paid into court.

Where it is intended that maintenance payments are to be paid into Court, and the Judicial Officer orders that the payments by made into the Court's custodial bank account maintained for this purpose, the Judicial Officer should seek to ensure that the maintenance order provides clarity in that it clearly indicates how compliance can be achieved. To achieve this, guidance is given that it is best that these orders include, in addition to the usual directions for maintenance, the following provisions:

1) a further direction that the said maintenance sums are to be paid by the payor into the Court's custodial account,

- 2) where applicable, that the maintenance sums are to be paid for the benefit of a minor (the Court should seek to ensure that the minor (or each minor) is identified by the inclusion of the minor's full name and date of birth together with the amount that is for that minor's benefit);
- 3) the amount that is to be received by the recipient;
- 4) that the said sums are to be paid into Court by paying them into the Court's Custodial Account using the CourtPay and paid out to the recipient using CourtPay;
- 5) that the transaction fee for the time being in force be paid and by whom it is to be paid;
- 6) that the parties register for CourtPay with the Court Office;
- that the Court Office provides the payor and recipient with instructions for use and any cost which may apply to use each method of payments in
- 8) that the parties are obligated to provide accurate information on registration for CourtPay
- 9) that the parties are obligated to inform the Court Office of any change in their address, email address, telephone number, and any account or method by which funds will be paid by the payor or received by the recipient.

A sample maintenance order is hereunder included for illustration:

THIS COURT ORDERS that

- the Respondent do pay to the Applicant for the maintenance of <u>"name of</u> <u>minor child"</u> born (Day/Month/ Year) the monthly sum of <u>xxx Dollars</u> (\$xxx.00) with effect from (day/Month/ Year) and continuing on the 1st day of every month until further order;
- 2) the Applicant and the Respondent shall immediately register for CourtPay with the Court Office of the Family Court;
- 3) Both the Applicant and the Respondent shall accurately provide to the Court
- 4) The Respondent shall pay the sum of xxx Dollars (\$xxx.00) specified in 1) above for the maintenance of <u>"name of minor child"</u> born (Day/Month/ Year), with effect from (day/Month/ Year) and continuing on the 1st day of every month until further order, into Court using CourtPay together with the transaction fee of five dollars (\$5.00) or such other transaction fee which may be prescribed by rules or practice direction;
- 5) The Applicant shall receive the sum of xxx Dollars (\$xxx.00) per month specified in 1) above for the benefit and maintenance of the minor child, *[state the name of the minor child]* via. CourtPay;
- 6) The parties shall immediately notify the Registrar of the Supreme Court at the Family Court of any change of address, e-mail or telephone number of the parties or of any alteration to the account or method by which funds will be paid by the Respondent or received by the Applicant;
- 7) That there be liberty to apply to vary this order
