ORDER

Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE, TOBAGO) ORDER, 2018

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Independence Day Parade, Tobago) Order, 2018.
- 2. This Order shall have effect from 7.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. on Duration Friday 31st August, 2018.
 - 3. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not drive on—

Vehicular traffic

- (a) Claude Noel Highway, between the intersection of Wilson prohibited Road and Claude Noel Highway and the junction of the Claude Noel Highway and Windward Main Road, Bacolet;
- (b) Claude Noel Highway and Friendsfield Road Junction to Calder Hall, phase 1; and
- (c) Darrell Spring Road and Wilson Road onto the Claude Noel Highway.
- 4. A driver of a motor vehicle may proceed in both directions along Two-way Carrington Street, between Garden Side Street and Wilson Road.
 - 5. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not park on—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Wilson Road, between Claude Noel Highway and Milford Road;
- (b) Bacolet Street;
- (c) Post Office Street;
- (d) Garden Side Street, between Darrell Spring Road and Carrington Street; and
- (e) Carrington Street.
- 6. The following public car parks will be closed from 6.00 p.m. on Car parks Thursday 30th August, 2018 to 11.00 a.m. on Friday 31st August, 2018: closed
 - (a) Garden Side Street;
 - (b) Market Square; and
 - (c) NIB Mall.

Parking permitted

- 7. A driver of a motor vehicle may park in the—
 - (a) car park east of the Dwight Yorke Stadium for members of the general public;
 - (b) Republic Bank car park; and
 - (c) Old Market car park, Piggott Street.

Traffic routes

- 8. A driver of a motor vehicle entering and exiting Scarborough—
 - (a) from east to west, shall turn onto Windward Road, Bacolet and continue along the road into Scarborough;
 - (b) from west to east, shall turn south onto Orange Hill Road to proceed into Scarborough;
 - (c) from west to east intending to turn north onto Wilson/Plymouth Road, shall do so and continue north;
 - (d) from the Northside Road, shall proceed straight across the Claude Noel Highway and into Scarborough;
 - (e) along Calder Hall Road, shall travel straight proceeding north and south respectively;
 - (f) to proceed to the eastern side of Tobago, shall proceed east along Carrington Street, onto Burnette Street, east along Main Street, south along Bacolet Street to the Claude Noel Highway, and then turn east along the Claude Noel Highway; and
 - (g) to proceed to the western side of Tobago, shall proceed west along Carrington Street, continuing west along Milford Road, north along Orange Hill Road to the Crusoe bypass or Claude Noel Highway and continue west.

Emergency routes

9. A driver of an emergency vehicle shall proceed north along Northside Connector Road to the Rockley Vale traffic light, west along the Claude Noel Highway, and then north along the Signal Hill Patience Hill Road to the Scarborough General Hospital.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 10. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed and impounded by a police officer in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
