THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, CHAP. 48:50

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE  
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)  
(TAROUBA) REGULATIONS, 2018

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation  
(Experimental Scheme) (Tarouba) Regulations, 2018.
2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 29th October, 2018 Duration  
and expire on Monday 28th January, 2019.
3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a northerly One-way  
direction only along the ramp connecting the Tarouba Overpass to the traffic  
southern roundabout within the Brian Lara Cricket Academy compound,  
except on days of events at the Brian Lara Cricket Academy of which  
advance notice will be given.
4. A person driving a motor vehicle proceeding in an westerly No right turn  
direction along Tarouba Link Road within the eastern section of the  
Tarouba Overpass, shall not turn right onto the ramp connecting the  
Tarouba Overpass and the southern roundabout within the Brian Lara  
Cricket Academy Compound.
5. A person driving a motor vehicle proceeding in a southerly No entry  
direction along the roadway within the Brian Lara Cricket Academy  
compound, south of the Gasparillo Bypass Road, shall not continue  
proceeding south towards the Tarouba Overpass after the southern  
roundabout within the Brian Lara Cricket Academy compound.
6. A person driving a private motor vehicle, motor cycle, public Entry to  
service vehicle or a goods vehicle, that is a maximum gross weight of specified motor  
2950kg, heading east across the Tarouba Overpass along the Tarouba vehicles  
Link Road, may enter the ramp connecting the Tarouba Overpass to the  
southern roundabout within the Brain Lara Cricket Academy compound.

Offence and  
penalty

7. A person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence, to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on any subsequent convictions, to a fine of one thousand dollars.
