MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(CARNIVAL) ORDER, 2018

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Carnival) Order, 2018.

PART I

PORT-OF-SPAIN

*Division 1—Vehicular Traffic and Parking*

2. (1) On Monday 12th February, 2018 (hereinafter called “Carnival Monday”), between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on the following roads and on all roads lying within and bounded by them:

- (a) Duke Street, between Belgrade Street and Wrightson Road;
- (b) Park Street, between Flament Street and Piccadilly Street;
- (c) Stone Street, between Park Street and Flament Street;
- (d) Flament Street, between Stone Street and Wrightson Road;
- (e) Independence Square North, between Wrightson Road and Piccadilly Street;
- (f) Independence Square South, between Wrightson Road and Piccadilly Street;
- (g) St. Joseph Road, between Piccadilly Street and Vieira Street;
- (h) Charlotte Street, between Queen’s Park East and West and South Quay;
- (i) Nelson Street;
- (j) Duncan Street;
- (k) Fraser Street;
- (l) Richmond Street;
- (m) Keate Street;

- (n) St. Vincent Street, between Gordon Street and South Quay;
- (o) Abercromby Street, between Gordon Street and South Quay;
- (p) Frederick Street, between Independence Square North and Queen's Park West;
- (q) Henry Street, between South Quay and Gordon Street;
- (r) Sackville Street;
- (s) Broadway;
- (t) Queen Street;
- (u) South Quay, between Nelson Street and Wrightson Road;
- (v) New Street, between Dundonald and Charlotte Streets;
- (w) Belmont Circular Road, between Charlotte Street and the entrance to the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (x) Phillip Street;
- (y) Tragarete Road, between Damien Street and St. Vincent Street; and
- (z) Piccadilly Street, between Park Street and South Quay.

(2) Notwithstanding clause 2(1)(t), taxis plying the San Fernando, Chaguanas, Sangre Grande, Arima and Tunapuna to Port-of-Spain Route may park as outlined at clause 12 and 14.

(3) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. and Tuesday 13th February, 2018 (hereinafter called "Carnival Tuesday"), between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on the following roads lying within and bounded by the specified roads:

- (a) Elizabeth Street, between Serpentine Road and Tragarete Road;
- (b) Havelock Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;
- (c) Broome Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;
- (d) Kavanagh Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;
- (e) Robert Street;
- (f) Hunter Street;
- (g) Brabrant Street;
- (h) Kelly Kenny Street;

- (i) Hamilton Holder Street;
- (j) French Street;
- (k) Gatacre Street;
- (l) Colville Street;
- (m) Sackville Street;
- (n) London Street;
- (o) Queen's Park East, between St. Ann's Roundabout and Queen's Park West;
- (p) Jerningham Avenue, between Queen's Park East and Archer Street;
- (q) Charlotte Street, between Queen's Park West and South Quay;
- (r) Laventille Road, between Quarry Street and Piccadilly Street;
- (s) Observatory Street, between Quarry Street and Charlotte Street;
- (t) Piccadilly Street, between Park Street and South Quay;
- (u) South Quay, between Piccadilly Street and Wrightson Road;
- (v) Independence Square North;
- (w) Independence Square South;
- (x) Siparia Hill;
- (y) Bath Street;
- (z) Basilon Street;
- (aa) Belgrade Street;
- (bb) Mary Street, between Serpentine Road and Hayes Street;
- (cc) Hayes Street, between Serpentine Road and Maraval Road;
- (dd) Flood Street, between Serpentine Road and Alexandra Street;
- (ee) Flood Street, between Mary Street and Maraval Road; and
- (ff) Pole Carew Street.

4. (1) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. and Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m.—

- (a) parking is prohibited on the following streets bounded by Wrightson Road on the south and Ariapita Avenue on the north:
  - (i) Petra Street;
  - (ii) Ana Street;

- (iii) Gallus Street;
- (iv) Alberto Street;
- (v) Rosalino Street;
- (vi) Luis Street;
- (vii) Alfredo Street;
- (viii) Carlos Street;
- (ix) Murray Street;
- (x) Fitt Street; and
- (xi) Cornelio Street; and

(b) vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions on the streets referred to in paragraph (a).

(2) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., parking is prohibited on the following streets:

- (a) Oxford Street, between Observatory Street and Dundonald Street; and
- (b) Stone Street.

(3) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., parking is prohibited on the following streets:

- (a) Circular Road, between Maraval Road and St. Ann's Roundabout;
- (b) Queen's Park East, between St. Ann's Roundabout and Jerningham Avenue;
- (c) Maraval Road, between Circular Road and Tragarete Road;
- (d) St. Clair Avenue;
- (e) Damian Street;
- (f) De Verteuil Street;
- (g) Dennis Mahabir Street;
- (h) Wrightson Road;
- (i) Beetham Highway, between Abattoir Road and the intersection of Wrightson Road and South Quay;
- (j) Vieira Street;
- (k) Abattoir Road;
- (l) St. Joseph Road;
- (m) Foster Road;
- (n) Plaisance Road;
- (o) Picton Road;

- (p) Laventille Road;
- (q) Quarry Street;
- (r) Belgrade Street;
- (s) Codrington Street;

- (v) Oxford Street, East of Observatory Street;
- (w) Belmont Circular Road, between Observatory Street and Queen's Park East;

5. (1) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., drivers shall proceed in a southerly direction only along Stone Street, between Wrightson Road and Park Street. <sup>One-way traffic</sup>

(2) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. and Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., vehicular traffic shall proceed in—

- (a) a southerly direction only along Archer Street, between Belmont Circular Road and Jerningham Avenue;
- (b) an easterly direction only, along Cadiz Road;
- (c) a westerly direction only, along Prada Street, between Maraval Road and Wainwright Street;
- (d) an easterly direction only, along Belmont Circular Road, between Queen's Park East and Norfolk Street;

- (e) a southerly direction only, along Norfolk Street, between Belmont Circular Road and Jerningham Avenue; and
- (f) a westerly direction only, along Jerningham Avenue, between Norfolk Street and Queen's Park East.

6. (1) Between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and midnight on Carnival Monday and Carnival Tuesday, vehicular traffic shall proceed in both directions:

- (a) around the Queen's Park Savannah, between Queen's Park West, Casual Corner and Jerningham Avenue;
- (b) on Observatory Street, between Quarry Street and Belmont Circular Road;
- (c) on Belmont Circular Road, between Observatory Street and the entrance to the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (d) on Oxford Street, between Observatory Street and Charlotte Street;
- (e) on Gaston Johnson Street;
- (f) on Panka Street, between Gaston Johnson Street and Lucknow Street; and
- (g) on Lucknow Street.

(2) On Carnival Tuesday only the Northbound Carriageway of Maraval Parkway shall be two-way traffic between Belle Smythe Street and Wrightson Road.

7. Vehicular traffic *en route* to the Port-of-Spain General Hospital on an emergency shall proceed along one of the following routes and shall leave by the reverse route:

- (a) north along Henry Street, turning east onto New Street, into the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (b) north along Edward Street, turning east onto New Street into the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (c) north along French Street, continuing onto Maraval Road, turning east onto Warner Street, south onto Cipriani Boulevard, east onto Melville Street, south onto Dundonald Street, east onto New Street to the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (d) north along Long Circular Road, onto Maraval Road, turning south onto Maraval Road, east on onto Warner Street, south onto Cipriani Boulevard, east onto Melville Street, south onto Dundonald Street, east onto New Street to the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (e) west along Lady Young Road, turning south on Queen's Park East, continuing onto Charlotte Street and turning east into the Hospital via the Maternity Ward Entrance; and

(f) east along Sackville Street, turning north onto Edward Street, east onto New Street and into the Port-of-Spain General Hospital.

*Division 2—Taxi and Maxi-taxi Stands*

8. This Division has effect on Carnival Monday between the hours Duration of 2.00 a.m. and midnight on Carnival Tuesday.

9. Taxi drivers assigned to taxi stands on Chacon Street, between Long Independence Square South and South Quay (Long Circular/Wrightson Circular/Wrightson Road) shall operate on the northern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and the entrance to the Port Authority. taxi stands

10. Taxi drivers assigned to taxi stands on South Quay, between Diego Martin/ Broadway and Abercromby Street (Diego Martin/Petit Valley) shall Petit Valley/ St. James operate on the southern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road taxi stands and the entrance to the Port Authority.

11. Taxi drivers assigned to taxi stands on the southern side of "On-call" / Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and Ice House taxi stands St. Vincent Street and on the eastern and western sides of Cipriani Roundabout, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South (On-call taxis) shall operate on Charles Street, from Scott Bushe Street, facing west.

12. Taxi drivers assigned to taxi stands on Broadway, between San Fernando/ South Quay and Independence Square South (San Fernando/ Chaguanas Chaguanas) shall operate on the northern side of South Quay, between taxi stands George Street and Nelson Street, facing east.

13. Taxi drivers assigned to the Morvant/Trou-Macaque Route Morvant/Trou shall operate on the southern side of the east bound carriage way, off Macaque taxi stands the Old St. Joseph Road, east of Piccadilly Street, facing east.

14. Taxi drivers assigned to taxi stands on Henry Street, between Tunapuna/ Independence Square South and South Quay (Tunapuna/Arima/Sangre Arima/ Sangre Grande/San Juan and Round-the-Road) shall operate on the southern Grande taxi side of South Quay, between Nelson Street and George Street, facing stands east.

15. Taxi drivers assigned to the taxi stand at Queen Street and Belmont taxi Charlotte Street shall operate on Observatory Street and Charlotte stand Street.

16. Taxi drivers assigned to the taxi stand at Duke Street and Maraval taxi Charlotte Street shall operate on Belmont Circular Road and Belle Eau stand Road.

17. Route 1 maxi-taxis drivers (yellow band) shall enter the maxi-taxi stand on South Quay by way of the Beetham Highway and exit by way of South Quay, on the southern side, forty metres east of the Beetham Highway.

18. (1) Bands shall enter the Queen's Park Savannah Competition Centre by proceeding north along Charlotte Street, turning west onto Queen's Park West and north into the Queen's Park Savannah via the Frederick Street entrance.

(2) Bands shall exit the Queen's Park Savannah by proceeding south onto Victoria Avenue and turning east onto Tragarete Road.

19. Bands shall enter the Adam Smith Square Competition Centre by way of Tragarete Road, turn south onto Pole Carew Street and then proceed east along Ariapita Avenue.

Bands shall enter the South Quay Competition Centre by proceeding south along St. Vincent Street, then turn east onto South Quay and north onto Charlotte Street and may either proceed west onto Queen's Park West, turning north into the Grand Stand, or west along Park Street and then turn north onto St. Vincent Street and continue onto Tragarete Road.

21. Bands shall enter the Soca Drome by proceeding south along Damian Street, then continue south onto Taylor Street, turn west onto Ariapita Avenue, south onto Maraval Parkway and turn west into the Hasley Crawford Stadium via Castro Gate.

22. Bands shall enter Piccadilly Street Competition Centre by proceeding east along Independence Square South, turning north onto Piccadilly Street and exit by continuing north along Piccadilly Street, turning west onto Park Street, north onto Charlotte Street, then west onto Queen's Park West to proceed to the Queen's Park Savannah.

23. Vehicles shall enter the Queen's Park Savannah at the following points:

- (a) Queen's Park East, near St. Ann's Roundabout; and
- (b) Queen's Park West, Casuals Corner.

24. Vehicles shall exit the Queen's Park Savannah at Queen's Park West (Casuals Corner) or in accordance with the directions of police officers on duty.



25. (1) Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, motorists attending the parade of bands at the DRAG may park their vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah, commencing three hours before the start of the function and exit three hours after the closure of the function.

(2) Parking on the Queen's Park Savannah shall be in accordance with the directions of the police officers on duty.

*Division 4—Traffic Lights*

26. Automatic traffic lights shall not be in operation between the hours of 2.00 a.m. on Carnival Monday and midnight on Carnival Tuesday.

PART II

ST. JAMES

27. This Part has effect between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Carnival Monday and between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Carnival Tuesday.

28. Parking is prohibited on—

- (a) Western Main Road, between Damien Street and Mucurapo Link Road;
- (b) Matura Street, between Western Main Road and Mucurapo Road;
- (c) Mucurapo Road, between Mucurapo Link Road and Ana Street;
- (d) Damien Street, between Western Main Road and Mucurapo Road;
- (e) Taylor Street, between Mucurapo Road and Ariapita Avenue;
- (f) Long Circular Road, between Western Main Road and Delhi Street;
- (g) Delhi Street, between Long Circular Road and Mooneram Kathleen Street;
- (h) Kathleen Street, between Mooneram Street and George Cabral Street;
- (i) Salazar Street, between George Cabral Street and Church Street;
- (j) Church Street, between Salazar Street and George Cabral Street;

Parking prohibited

- (k) George Cabral Street, between Western Main Road and Bournes Road;
- (l) Patna Street, between Bournes Road and Long Circular Road; and
- (m) Bournes Road, between Western Main Road and Panta Street.
- Taxi stands        29. (1) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m, taxis stands shall operate as follows:
- (a) Port-of-Spain taxis, on the corner of Long Circular Road and Barbados Road, St. James; and
- (b) taxis heading west, on the corner of Coronation Street and Western Main Road, St. James.
- (2) Between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. on Carnival Monday only, persons can access taxis on Mucurapo Road and Audrey Jeffers Highway, St. James.
- Emergency routes        30. In cases of emergency, motorists shall access—
- (a) the St. James Medical Facility by proceeding north along Long Circular Road, between Western Main Road and Delhi Street, turning west onto Delhi Street, continuing onto Kathleen Street, south onto George Cabral Street, then turning west onto Western Main Road, and shall exit the St. James Medical Facility proceeding along the route in the opposite direction; and
- (b) the Port-of-Spain General Hospital via Saddle Road, Maraval, or Barbados Road.
- Alternate route        31. During the period that any Mas Band shall be passing through Western Main Road, St. James, motorists shall proceed along Mucurapo Road and Panta Street, St. James.
- Evacuation plan        32. In cases of emergency, masqueraders and spectators shall be directed to evacuate the area via any of the emergency routes referred to in clause 30, on which police officers shall be deployed to assist with the flow of both vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

33. Muster points are designated as follows: Muster point
- (a) the Training Ground;
  - (b) the National Stadium; and
  - (c) the St. James Police Station.
34. Vehicular traffic proceeding— vehicular

- (2) On Carnival Monday and Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and midnight, vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on—
- (a) the Eastern Main Road, between First Avenue and Aranguez Main Road for vehicles proceeding east;

- (b) the Eastern Main Road, between Aranguez Main Road and Saddle Road for vehicles proceeding west;
- (c) Saddle Road, between the Eastern Main Road and First Street;
- (d) Second Street, between First Avenue and Saddle Road; and
- (e) Coldatinda Avenue.
