NOTICE OF FINAL ACTION ON THE 2018 NATIONAL
ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

ISSUED UNDER SECTION 29 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has completed the revision of the 2018 National Environmental Policy (“the NEP”) pursuant to Section 18(5) of the Environmental Management Act, Chap. 35:05 (“the Act”), which provides that the Authority may, from time to time, revise the NEP. The revision of the NEP was considered necessary given the vast changes in the environmental, development, economic and social paradigm of Trinidad and Tobago since the publication of the NEP in 2006.

And take notice that the Minister with the responsibility for the environment, caused the 2018 NEP to be laid in Parliament on 2nd November, 2018, in accordance with Section 18(6) of the Act.

And take notice that the Authority has, pursuant to Section 29 of the Act, established an Administrative Record for the final action that includes a written description of the final action, copies of the document constituting the final action, a response to public comments received and identification of the basis for the final action.
