ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 37 OF THE
EXPLOSIVES ACT

EXPLOSIVES (PROHIBITION OF SCRATCH BOMBS) ORDER, 2018

1. This Order may be cited as the Explosives (Prohibition of Scratch Bombs) Order, 2018. Citation

2. In this Order, “scratch bomb” means an explosive which— Definition

- (a) has a friction sensitive head and is ignited by applying friction or an open flame to the friction sensitive head;
- (b) is designed to be hand-held and thrown upon being ignited; and
- (c) explodes and produces a pyrotechnic effect, including a flash, a loud noise, heat or flames.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Explosives (Manufacture of Fireworks) Order, no person shall manufacture, import, keep, convey or sell a scratch bomb. Prohibition of scratch bombs Chap. 16:02

4. A person who contravenes clause 3 is liable to be dealt with in accordance with sections 38 and 39 of the Act. Liability for contravention
