ORDER

Made by the Minister under section 37 of the Explosives Act

EXPLOSIVES (PROHIBITION OF SCRATCH BOMBS) ORDER, 2018

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Explosives (Prohibition of Scratch Citation Bombs) Order, 2018.
 - 2. In this Order, "scratch bomb" means an explosive which— Definition
 - (a) has a friction sensitive head and is ignited by applying friction or an open flame to the friction sensitive head;
 - (b) is designed to be hand-held and thrown upon being ignited; and
 - (c) explodes and produces a pyrotechnic effect, including a flash, a loud noise, heat or flames.
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Explosives (Manufacture Prohibition of Scratch bombs of Fireworks) Order, no person shall manufacture, import, keep, convey Chap. 16:02 or sell a scratch bomb.
- 4. A person who contravenes clause 3 is liable to be dealt with in Liability for accordance with sections 38 and 39 of the Act.
