REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)
(ARIMA) REGULATIONS, 2018

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation
(Experimental Scheme) (Arima) Regulations, 2018.
2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 5th March, 2018 Duration
and expire on Monday 4th June, 2018.
3. Taxi drivers shall park and ply for hire as follows: Taxi stands
 - (a) the Arima to Sangre Grande route—a maximum of twelve taxis, on the northern side of Sorzano Street, between Woodford Street and Queen Street, as marked, facing east; and
 - (b) the Arima to Valencia route—a maximum of five taxis, on the eastern side of Queen Street, between Sorzano Street and Broadway, as marked, facing south.
4. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park the motor vehicle Parking Prohibited
on Queen Street, from its intersection with Broadway to a point sixty metres south of the said intersection, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.
5. A person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on Offence and penalty
summary conviction for a first offence, to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction, to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and
impounding
of vehicles

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
