Made by the Commissioner of Police under Section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (PRESIDENT INAUGURATION) ORDER, 2018

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (President Inauguration) Order, 2018.

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and Duration 2.00 p.m. on Monday 19th March, 2018.

3. Parking is prohibited on the following roads and all roads lying Parking within and bounded by them:

- (a) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;
- (b) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane;
- (c) Chancery Lane, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West; and
- (d) around the Queen's Park Savannah.

4. (1) Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, motorists Parking of attending the inauguration may park their vehicles on the Queen's vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah, commencing three hours before the start of the Park function and exit three hours after the closure of the function.

(2) Parking on the Queen's Park Savannah shall be in accordance with the directions of the police officers on duty.

5. Vehicles shall enter the Queen's Park Savannah at the following Entry of vehicles in the Output of vehicles in the Output of the Output of

vehicles into the Queen's Park Savannah

(a) Queen's Park East, near St. Ann's Roundabout;

- (b) Queen's Park West, Casual Corner; and
- (c) Queen's Park West, Victoria Avenue.

Exit of vehicles from the Queen's Park Savannah	6. Vehicles shall exit the Queen's Park Savannah at—
	(a) Queen's Park West, Casual Corner;
	(b) Queen's Park West, Victoria Avenue; or
	(c) in accordance with the directions of police officers on duty.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the

Removal and impounding commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
