ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(TOBAGO JAZZ EXPERIENCE) ORDER, 2018

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Tobago Jazz Experience) Order, 2018.

PART I

SPEYSIDE

2. This Part shall have effect in Speyside, from 12.00 noon on Saturday 28th April, 2018 to 1.00 a.m. on Sunday 29th April, 2018.

3. Parking is prohibited on—

- (a) Windward Road, between the Speyside Public Cemetery and the Speyside Community Centre; and
- (b) Lucy Vale Road, to the bridge.

Parking prohibited

4. Parking is permitted—

- (a) on Lucy Vale Recreation Ground;
- (b) on the northern side of Lucy Vale Road, from the bridge, westward;
- (c) on the northern side of Windward Road, between Kings Bay Waterfall and the Speyside Public Cemetery;
- (d) on the northern side of Windward Road, from the Speyside Community Centre, eastward;
- (e) in the outer car park of the Speyside High School; and
- (f) in the case of V.I.P. parking, at the Speyside Playing Field and in the inner car park of the Speyside High School.

Parking permitted

PART II
CROWN POINT

- Duration 5. This Part shall have effect in Crown Point, from 12.00 noon on Sunday 29th April, 2018 to 1.00 a.m. on Monday 30th April, 2018.
- Parking prohibited 6. Parking is prohibited on—
- (a) Milford Road, from Guy Street Extension (Azards' Tyre Shop) and the ANR Robinson International Airport;
 - (b) Kilgwyn Bay Road Extension (Stumpy's By-Pass) to Store Bay Local Road;
 - (c) Store Bay Local Road;
 - (d) Milford Road By-Pass; and
 - (e) Pigeon Point Road.
- Parking permitted 7. Parking is permitted—
- (a) in Store Bay Heritage Park, Milford Road By-Pass, Crown Point;
 - (b) in Store Bay beach facilities car park; and
 - (c) in the case of vehicles with V.V.I.P. passes—
 - (i) at the venue of the activities; or
 - (ii) on Pigeon Point Road.
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, a vehicle found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by a police officer and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
