IT IS ORDERED THAT personal service on the Defendant be dispensed with.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that pursuant to section 22B(3)(a) of the Anti-Terrorism Act Chap. 12:07, the

Pursuant to section 22B(5) of the Act, the Attorney General shall within seven (7) days after the date of this Order, cause a copy of the Order and a statement that the matter will be reviewed every six (6) months, to be published in the Trinidad and Tobago Gazette and in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in Trinidad and Tobago; and
- 4. Liberty to apply.
