### GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of November, 2018 was 108.3, representing an increase of 0.3 point or 0.3% above the All Items Index for October, 2018.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January to November, 2018 over the period January to November, 2017 was 1.0%. This rate is less than that observed for the period January to November, 2017 over the period January to November, 2016, which was 1.9%.

## SECTION INDICES

### FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Sections

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 114.4 in October, 2018 to 116.2 in November, 2018, reflecting an increase of 1.6%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of tomatoes; cucumber; melongene; chive; celery; ochroes; pumpkin; bodi; mixed fresh seasoning; and cabbage. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decrease in the prices of fresh whole chickens; grapes; fresh steak; (beef); carrots; evaporated milk; split peas; Irish potatoes; onions; full cream powdered milk; and other fresh pork..

Price changes in this section for the month of November, 2018, accounted for a net overall increase of 0.3 point in the All Items Index.

# OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for November, 2018, compared with October, 2018, reflected an increase in the sub-indices for Alcholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.2%, and Health of 0.1%. However, a decrease was noted in the sub-index for clothing and Footwear of 0.5%. All other sections remained unchanged.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of October, 2018 had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.
