ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(ARIMA BOROUGH DAY CELEBRATIONS) ORDER, 2019

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Arima Borough Day Celebrations) Order, 2019.

2. This Order has effect from 4.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight on Duration Saturday 10th August, 2019.

3. (1) A driver of a motor vehicle proceeding to Arima— Vehicular  
traffic routes
- (a) from the west along Eastern Main Road, shall turn north onto Industry Street, east onto Anglican Street, north onto King Street, east onto Sorzano Street, south onto Queen Street and east onto Broadway;
  - (b) from the east along Guanapo Street, shall turn west onto Broadway, west onto the Arima Old Road, south onto Beckles Lane and west onto the Eastern Main Road; and
  - (c) from the south, along Cocorite Road, shall turn west onto Broadway, west onto the Arima Old Road, south onto Beckles Lane and west onto the Eastern Main Road.

(2) A driver of a motor vehicle shall enter the Arima Police Station via Green Street and shall exit the Arima Police Station by proceeding west along Broadway.

4. (1) A driver of a maxi-taxi proceeding east along the Priority Priority Bus  
Route maxi-  
taxis Bus Route to Arima shall turn north onto Railway Road, west onto Providence Street and then onto the Eastern Main Road.

(2) A driver of a maxi-taxi proceeding east along the Eastern Main Road to Arima shall turn north onto Industry Street, north onto Church Street, south onto St. Joseph Street and then onto the Priority Bus Route maxi-taxi stand.

- Eastern Main Road maxi-taxi stand      5. A driver of a maxi-taxi proceeding along the Eastern Main Road to Arima shall turn north onto Industry Street, east onto Anglican Street, north onto King Street, east onto Rose Street, north onto St. Joseph Street and then onto the Eastern Main Road maxi-taxi stand.
- Priority Bus Route buses      6. A driver of a bus proceeding east along the Priority Bus Route to Arima shall turn north onto Railway Road, north onto Queen Mary Avenue, west onto the Eastern Main Road and onto the bus terminus on the southern side of John Shaw Avenue, facing west, in front of the Arima Health Centre.
- Parking and vehicular traffic prohibited      7. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not park or proceed on—
- (a) Industry Street, between Eastern Main Road and Anglican Street;
  - (b) Anglican Street, between Industry Street and King Street;
  - (c) King Street, between Hollis Avenue and Church Street;
  - (d) Church Street, between King Street and Prince Street;
  - (e) Queen Street, between Sorzano and Hollis Avenue;
  - (f) Railway Road and Queen Mary Avenue, between the Priority Bus Route and Eastern Main Road;
  - (g) Providence Street, between Railway Road and the Eastern Main Road;
  - (h) Cocorite Road, between Broadway and Quesnel Street;
  - (i) Beckles Lane, between the Arima Old Road and the Eastern Main Road; and
  - (j) Lopez Street.
- Road closed      8. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not proceed on—
- (a) Hollis Avenue, between Industry Street and Queen Street; and
  - (b) Pro Queen Street, between Hollis Avenue and Robinson Circular.
- Bus routes      9. A driver of a Public Transport Service Corporation bus proceeding to—
- (a) Arima from the east along Guanapo Street shall turn west onto Broadway, south onto Cocorite Road and then onto Devenish Street; and

(b) Sangre Grande, shall turn south onto Quesnel Street and east onto the Eastern Main Road.

10. A driver of a maxi-taxi shall operate—

Maxi-taxi stands

(a) a Sangre Grande maxi-taxi on the eastern side of Raglon Street, facing south, between Sorzano and Guanapo Street; and

(b) an Eastern Main Road maxi-taxi and a Priority Bus Route maxi-taxi, on their respective stands, on St Joseph Street.

11. A driver of a taxi shall operate—

Taxi stands

(a) a Port-of-Spain, Mt. Pleasant, Calvary Hill, Cumuto, Sangre Grande, Pinto Road, Cocorite Road and La Horquetta taxi respectively, from its current location;

(b) a Mausica old Road taxi from King Street, facing north; and

(c) a Malabar taxi and a Carapo taxi respectively, from Loubon Street, on the southern side, facing west.

12. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. <sup>Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked</sup>
