THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, CHAP. 48:50

REGULATIONS

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister of Works and Transport under Section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (BELMONT, PORT-OF-SPAIN, ST. JAMES AND WOODBROOK) REGULATIONS, 2019

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) (Belmont, Port-of-Spain, St. James and Woodbrook) Regulations, 2019.
- 2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 9th September, Duration 2019 and expire on Sunday 8th December, 2019.

PART I

BELMONT

3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a-

One-way traffic

- (a) westerly direction only on Meyler Street, between Belmont Circular Road East and Pelham Street;
- (b) southerly direction only on Pelham Street, between Belmont Circular Road North and Clifford Street;
- (c) easterly direction only on St. Margaret's Lane, between Belmont Circular Road East and Pelham Street; and
- (d) westerly direction only on Cadiz Road, between Archer Street and Queen's Park Savannah between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays, except on public holidays.
- 4. No person shall park a motor vehicle on the northern side of Parking Cadiz Road, between Archer Street and Queen's Park Savannah during prohibited the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays, except on public holidays.

PART II

PORT-OF-SPAIN

Parking prohibited

- 5. (1) No person shall park a motor vehicle on—
 - (a) the southern side of Queen Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;
 - (b) Independence Square North and Independence Square South, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays, except on public holidays; and
 - (c) Knox Street, between Abercromby Street and Pembroke Street.
- (2) No person shall park a motor vehicle, trailer or place a container on Queen Street, between St. Vincent Street and Richmond Street, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays, except on public holidays.

PART III

St. James

No entry

6. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not enter Finland Street from Vidale Street.

Parking prohibited

- 7. No person shall park a motor vehicle on—
 - (a) the northern side of Finland Street, between Ethel Street and Vidale Street; and
 - (b) the western side of Clarence Street.

PART IV

WOODBROOK

No right turn

8. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not turn right from Belle Smythe Street to Warrren Street, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays, except on public holidays.

Parking prohibited

- 9. No person shall park a motor vehicle on—
 - (a) de Verteuil Street, between Warren Street and Ariapita Avenue on the—
 - (i) eastern side, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays;
 - (ii) western side, on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays; and

- (b) Alberto Street on the—
 - (i) eastern side, on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays;
 - (ii) western side on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

PART V

GENERAL

- 10. A person who contravenes these Regulations commits an Offence and offence and is liable on summary conviction for a first offence, to a fine penalty of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.
- 11. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in impounding of vehicles contravention of these Regulations, may be removed by a member of the unlawfully Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section parked 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Act.
