THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 6) ORDER, 2019

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 6) Order, 2019. Citation

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule. Mr. Thomas Michael Chard Allen, QC, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an Attorney-at-law in relation to anticipated proceedings arising out of or in connection with offences of conspiracy to commit money laundering, conspiracy to commit misbehaviour in public office and conspiracy to commit an act of corruption contrary to the Prevention of Corruption Act, Chap. 11:11.
