- (b) a valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act. (applicable to local firms).

The original tender on the approved Tender Form and (3) copies should be placed in sealed envelopes clearly marked on the outside: "Tender for the Supply and Delivery of One (1) Hydraulic Long Reach Excavator, Ministry of Agriculture, Land and Fisheries."

Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and must be deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 30th July, 2020.
