INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—January, 2020 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

### GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of January, 2020 was 108.9 representing an increase of 0.3 point or 0.3% above the All Items Index for December, 2019.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January, 2020 over the period January, 2019 was 0.4%. This rate is less than that observed for the period January, 2019 over the period January, 2018 which was 1.4%.

## SECTION INDICES

# FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 114.9 in December, 2019 to 116.5 in January, 2020 reflecting an increase of 1.4%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of whole chickens–fresh; carite–fresh; cucumber; melongene; chive; cabbage; onions; brown sugar; king fish–fresh and bodi. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decrease in the prices of sweet potatoes; oranges; shrimp–fresh; grapes; bananas–ripe; orange drink; chedder cheese; fresh, chilled frozen or seasoned beef; ketchup and mangoes.

Price changes in this section for the month of January, 2020 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.3 points in the All Items Index.

### OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for January, 2020 compared with December, 2019 reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.5%; Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels of 0.2%; Health of 1.0%; and Miscellaneous Goods and Services of 0.2%. However, decreases were noted in sub- indices for Clothing and Footwear of 0.8%; Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Maintenance of 0.1%; Transport of 0.3%; Recreation and Culture of 0.2%; and Hotels, Cafés and Restaurant of 0.1%.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of January, 2020, had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.
