APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE

(*Customs Act, Chap. 78:01*)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Kathy Ann Matthews, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 263 (2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereunder to be a Private Warehouse for the storage, pending entry for home consumption or export, of the following goods, as shall be warehoused by Messrs. F. T. Farfan Limited of Light Pole No. 4, Alexander Trace, Monroe Road, Cunupia, various oils, greases, coolants, filters and other such goods as I may approve.

SCHEDULE

An enclosed area measuring 24.4 metres by 18.3 metres, a total area of 446.52 metres. The western, northern and eastern walls consist of brick and mortar up to the roof. The southern wall consists of BRC wire up to the roof with a single sliding gate of BRC wire being the entrance to the enclosure.

The area is situate at Bay 6 at the eastern end of the F. T. Farfan building which consists primarily of brick and mortar and a roof of iron and steel.

The building is surrounded on the north, east and southern sides by a wall of brick and mortar. The western side consists of a concrete wall and an iron gate adjoining the main roadway.

The property is bounded on the north by an empty lot of land, on the east and south by private dwellings and on the west by Alexander Trace.
