NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE WHICH REQUIRES AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT SUBMITTED BY EOG RESOURCES TRINIDAD – U(A) BLOCK LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that EOG Resources Trinidad - U(a) Block Limited are desirous of the installation of the Osprey East Platform and drilling of nine (9) development wells, within the existing U(a) Block and the installation of a new 5-kilometre (km), 10-inch subsea multiphase pipeline, from the Osprey East Platform to the existing Osprey Platform approximately 55 km off the East Coast of Trinidad. This project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance pursuant to **Section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, Chapter 35:05 (“the Act”)**. EOG Resources Trinidad - U(a) Block Limited has applied for a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) from the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) for this project.

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And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the application for the Installation of the Osprey East Platform and drilling of nine (9) development wells, within the existing U(a) Block and the installation of a new 5-km, 10-inch subsea multiphase pipeline, from the Osprey East Platform to the existing Osprey Platform approximately 55 km off the East Coast of Trinidad, which requires an Environmental Impact Assessment.

And take notice that the Authority has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to **Section 28(I)(b)** of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and of the Authority's reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing from **Monday 17th August, 2020 to Friday 18th September, 2020** between the hours **8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays** at the following offices:-
