NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE WHICH REQUIRES AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT SUBMITTED BY THE NATIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT COMPANY LIMITED (NIDCO) ON BEHALF OF THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT (MOWT)

NOTICE is hereby given that the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT) of the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago is desirous of the establishment of a modern, multipurpose port facility on 19.9 hectares of land, along with associated dredging, reclamation, other earthworks and infrastructural works at Grande Anse Bay, Toco, North Coast of Trinidad. This project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance pursuant to **Section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, Chapter 35:05 (“the Act”)**. MOWT has applied for a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) from the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) for this project.

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the application for the establishment of a modern, multipurpose port facility on 19.9 hectares of land, along with associated dredging, reclamation, other earthworks and infrastructural works at Grande Anse Bay, Toco, North Coast of Trinidad, which requires an Environmental Impact Assessment.

And take notice that the Authority has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to **Section 28(l)(b)** of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.
