INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER DECLARING
COMPULSORY STANDARDS

NOTICE is hereby given in accordance with section 18(2) of the Standards Act, Chap. 82:03, that the Minister of Trade and Industry, on the recommendation of the Trinidad and Tobago Bureau of Standards, intends to make an Order declaring the standards listed in the First Column with the corresponding titles listed in the Second Column as compulsory standards, with effect from 4th day of January, 2021, for the purposes specified in the Third Column of the Schedule.

TTCS 2:2020	Concrete masonry units— Compulsory requirements.	To protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety and ensure acceptable quality in products for home use or export.
TTCS 4:2020	Rolled structural steel products— Bars, plates, shapes and sheet piling—Compulsory requirements	To protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety and ensure acceptable quality in products for home use or export.
