A PROCLAMATION

Whereas it is provided by section 30 of the Representation of the People Act, Chap. 2:01 that, for the purposes of an election, the President may, by Proclamation published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in the Registration Area Offices or the Temporary Registration Area Offices established in the electoral district in which such election is to be held:

Now, therefore, I, Paula-Mae Weekes, President as aforesaid, do hereby direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in each of the electoral districts defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government and Tobago House of Assembly) (Tobago) Order, 2020, in relation to the electoral area of Tobago, for the purposes of the election of members to serve on the Tobago House of Assembly and I hereby fix the 17th day of December, 2020 as the date of the commencement of the said electoral registration.

- 11. Providence/Mason Hall/Moriah; and
- 12. Scarborough/Calder Hall.
