REGULATIONS

Made by the Minister under section 105 of the Public Health Ordinance

THE PUBLIC HEALTH [2019 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (2019-nCoV)] REGULATIONS, 2020

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health [2019 Novel Citation Coronavirus (2019-nCoV)] Regulations, 2020.
- 2. (1) For the purposes of controlling and preventing the spread of Restriction of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV), it shall be an offence, during certain activities the period specified in regulation 3, for any person—
 - (a) to conduct the business of a bar, whether or not the person is a licensed person under the Liquor Licences Act; Chap. 84:10
 - (b) to operate a club as defined in section 2 of the Registration of Clubs Act; or Chap. 21:01
 - (c) to provide the amenity of seated dining at a restaurant to any customer.
- (2) A person who contravenes subregulation (1) commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for six months.
- 3. These Regulations come into force on 21st March, 2020 and expire Duration on 31st July, 2020.
