MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 105 OF THE
PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE

THE PUBLIC HEALTH [2019 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS
(2019-nCoV)] (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2020

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health [2019 Novel
Coronavirus (2019-nCoV)] (No. 2) Regulations, 2020. Citation

2. (1) For the purposes of controlling and preventing the spread of
the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV), it shall be an offence, during
the period specified in regulation 4, for any person to— Restriction of
certain
activities

- (a) conduct the business of a bar, whether or not the person is a
licensed person under the Liquor Licences Act; Chap. 84:10
- (b) operate a club as defined in section 2 of the Registration of
Clubs Act; Chap. 21:01
- (c) operate a theatre licensed under the Cinematograph Act; or Chap. 20:10
- (d) provide the amenity of seated dining at a restaurant to any
customer.

(2) A person who contravenes subregulation (1) commits an offence
and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of fifty thousand dollars and
to imprisonment for six months.

3. The Public Health [2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV)]
Regulations, 2020 is hereby revoked. Legal Notice

4. These Regulations come into force on 21st March, 2020 and expire
on 20th April, 2020. Duration
