## Act No. 15 of 2021

## [L.S.]

AN ACT to amend the Emergency Ambulance Services and Emergency Medical Personnel Act, Chap. 29:02; the Pharmacy Board Act, Chap. 29:52; the Nursing Personnel Act, Chap. 29:53; the Dental Profession Act, Chap. 29:54; the Veterinary Surgeons (Registration) Act, Chap. 67:04; the Professions Related to Medicine Act, Chap. 90:04 to authorise additional personnel to administer 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) vaccines under the direction and supervision of medical practitioners

[Assented to 22nd November, 2021]

Enactment ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:

Short title

Chap. 29:02 amended 1. This Act may be cited as the Miscellaneous Provisions (2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) Vaccination Personnel) Act, 2021.

2. The Emergency Ambulance Services and Emergency Medical Personnel Act is amended, by inserting after section 36, the following section:

36A. (1) A person who is registered as an "Power to administer Emergency Medical Technician—Paramedic vaccine under this acting under Act. the direction supervision of medical or а practitioner, may administer a 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) vaccine or such other vaccine as the Minister may by Order, prescribe.

**3.** The Pharmacy Board Act is amended, by inserting after section 42, the following section:

42A. (1) A pharmacist acting under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner, may administer a 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) vaccine or such other vaccine as the Minister may by Order, prescribe.

(2) For the purposes of this section, "2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) vaccine" means a COVID-19 vaccine approved

4. The Nursing Personnel Act is amended, by Chap. 29:53 amended inserting after section 51B, the following section:

51C. (1) Nursing personnel acting under the "Power to administer direction or supervision of a medical practitioner, may administer a 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) vaccine or such other vaccine as the Minister may by Order, prescribe.

> (2) For the purposes of this section-

> > "medical practitioner" has the meaning assigned to it in section 2 of the Medical Board Act: and

> > "2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019nCoV) vaccine" means ล COVID-19 vaccine approved bv the Minister with responsibility for health on the recommendation of the Drug Advisory Committee in accordance with paragraph 7, Division 3 of the Second Schedule of the Food and Drugs Regulations.".

5. The Dental Profession Act is amended, by Chap. 29:54 amended inserting after section 44, the following section:

"Power to administer vaccine

44A. (1) A dentist or a person who is temporarily registered to practise dentistry under sections 15 and 16 of this Act, acting under the direction or supervision of a

medical practitioner, may administer a 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) vaccine or such other vaccine as the Minister may by Order, prescribe.

(2) For the purposes of this section—

- "medical practitioner" has the meaning assigned to it in section 2 of the Medical Board Act; and
- "2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019nCoV) vaccine" means a COVID-19 vaccine approved Minister by the with responsibility for health on the recommendation of the Drug Advisory Committee in accordance with paragraph 7, Division 3 of the Second Schedule of the Food and Drugs Regulations.".

6. The Veterinary Surgeons (Registration) Act is amended, by inserting after section 13, the following section:

13A. (1) A veterinary surgeon acting under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner, may administer a 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) vaccine or such other vaccine as the Minister may by Order, prescribe.

- (2) For the purposes of this section—
  - "medical practitioner" has the meaning assigned to it in section 2 of the Medical Board Act; and

"2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019nCoV) vaccine" means a COVID-19 vaccine approved by the Minister with responsibility for health on the recommendation of the Drug Advisory Committee in accordance with paragraph 7, Division 3 of the Second Schedule of the Food and Drugs Regulations.".

7. The Professions Related to Medicine Act is Chap. 90:04 amended, by inserting after section 20, the following amended section:

20A. (1) A Medical Laboratory Technician or Radiographer who is registered under this Act, acting under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner, may administer a 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) vaccine or such other vaccine as the Minister may by Order, prescribe.

- (2) For the purposes of this section—
  - "medical practitioner" has the meaning assigned to it in section 2 of the Medical Board Act; and
  - "2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019nCoV) vaccine" means a COVID-19 vaccine approved by the Minister with responsibility for health on the recommendation of the Drug Advisory Committee in accordance with paragraph 7, Division 3 of the Second Schedule of the Food and Drugs Regulations.".
