## **Act No. 5 of 2021**

AN ACT to amend the Electronic Payments into and  
out of Court Act, 2018

*[Assented to 21st April, 2021]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago Enactment  
as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Electronic Payments Short title  
into and out of Court (Amendment) Act, 2021.
2. This Act shall come into force on such date as is Commencement  
fixed by the President by Proclamation.



**3.** The Electronic Payments into and out of Court Act is amended by inserting after section 15, the following section:

“Deductions  
for certain  
charges

16. Where electronic payments are made into Court, the Judiciary of Trinidad and Tobago may, by agreement with a Financial Intermediary, cause the bank charges, credit card charges, debit card charges, chargeback, administrative and other fees to be deducted from the Custodial Bank Account referred to in section 5(1) and (2) of the Act.”.
