INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—November, 2020 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

Percentage Change

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of November, 2020, was 109.6, representing an increase of 0.1 point or 0.1% above the All Items Index for October, 2020.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January to November, 2020, over the period January to November, 2019, was 0.6%. This rate is less than that observed for the period January to November, 2019, over the period January to November, 2018, which was 1.0%.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Sections

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 120.4 in October, 2020, to 120.8 in November, 2020, reflecting an increase of 0.3%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of tomatoes, melongene, whole chickens—fresh, pumpkin, parboiled rice, ochroes, bodi, fresh, chilled, frozen or seasoned beef, salted pig tail, and cabbage. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decreases in the prices of cucumber, eddoes, potatoes, pimento, dasheen, powdered milk—full cream, celery, grapes, other fresh pork, and other fresh goat any cut.

Price changes in this section for the month of November, 2020, accounted for a net overall increase of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for November, 2020, compared with October, 2020, reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 1.9% and Health of 0.2%. However, a decrease was noted in the sub-index for Clothing and Footwear of 0.4%. All other sections remained unchanged.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of November, 2020, had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.
