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INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—April, 2021 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of April, 2021, was 110.3, representing an increase of 0.4 point or 0.4% above the All Items Index for March, 2021.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January to April, 2021 over the period January to April, 2020 was 0.9%. This rate is greater than that observed for the period January to April, 2020 over the period January to April, 2019, which was 0.5%.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 119.8 in March, 2021 to 119.6 in April, 2021, reflecting a decrease of 0.2%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of table margarine, carite—fresh, pumpkin, garlic, potatoes, cucumber, pimento, melongene, powdered milk—full cream and fresh, chilled frozen or seasoned beef. However, the full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general increases in the prices of whole chicken—fresh, cabbage, tomatoes, eddoes, soya bean oil, cocoa and chocolate based preparations, carbonated soft drinks, corn, pizzas (frozen, precooked and ready to serve meals) and macaroni.

Price changes in this section for the month of April, 2021, had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for April, 2021, compared with March, 2021, reflected increases in the sub-indices for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels of 1.6%, Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Maintenance of the House of 0.3%, Health of 0.2%, Transport of 0.2% and Hotels, Cafes and Restaurants of 0.2%. However, decreases were noted in sub-indices for Clothing and Footwear of 0.2% and Miscellaneous Goods and Services of 0.1%. All other sections remained unchanged.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of April, 2021 accounted for a 0.4 point increase in the All Items Index.
