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**CLOSING DATE FOR NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES
FOR ELECTION TO THE 35TH COUNCIL**

All Attorneys at Law are advised that:

1. The Closing Date for Nomination of Candidates for election of Officers and Ordinary Members of Council is **Thursday 18th February 2021 at 12:00 noon.**
2. The Annual General Meeting of the Law Association of Trinidad and Tobago will be held virtually on **Friday 19th March 2021 at 3:00 p.m.** via Zoom video-conferencing.
3. Nominations for the position of President, Vice President, Treasurer and Ten (10) Senior Ordinary Members and Five (5) Junior Ordinary Members must be made in writing on the prescribed Nomination Form. A separate nomination form is required for each position.
4. Nomination Forms can be obtained from the Office of the Law Association located at 2nd Floor 95-97 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and can be downloaded from the Law Association of Trinidad and Tobago's website <http://www.lawassociationtt.com>.
5. Pursuant to paragraph 9(2) of Part II of the Legal Profession Act 1986 only practitioner members who hold a valid practicing certificate for the law term 2020-2021 or who produce a receipt for payments of Annual Subscriptions and contributions to the Compensation Fund for the 2020-2021 law term with a 2019-2020 practicing certificate are eligible: - (a) to nominate candidates (b) to attend and vote at a general meeting or at an election of members of the Council, and (c) to be elected to the Council.
6. Every Nomination Form of a candidate for election to the Council shall be signed by not less than five (5) practitioner members and endorsed by the candidate.
