- (a) Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender (applicable to local firms);
- (b) Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act (applicable to local firms).

The original and two (2) copies of the tender should be placed in sealed envelopes addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and clearly marked on the outside of—"Tender for the Supply and Delivery of One (1) 4x4 Backhoe Loader to the Penal/Debe Regional Corporation, Ministry of Rural Development and Local Government".
