INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—December, 2020 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of December, 2020, was 109.5, representing a decrease of 0.1 point or 0.1% below the All Items Index for November, 2020.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January to December, 2020, over the period January to December, 2019, was 0.6%. This rate is less than that observed for the period January to December, 2019, over the period January to December, 2018, which was 1.0%.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 120.8 in November, 2020 to 120.1 in December, 2020, reflecting a decrease of 0.6%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of tomatoes, whole chickens—fresh, celery, eddoes, chive, cabbage, sports and energy drinks, tea-in bags, ochroes and grapes. The full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general increases in the prices of pumkin, other chilled or frozen chicken (parts), potatoes, carrots, carrie—fresh, cocoa and chocolate based preparations, salmon—fresh, shrimp—fresh, melongene and brown sugar.

Price changes in this section for the month of December, 2020 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for December, 2020 compared with November, 2020, reflected decreases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 1.0% and Clothing and Footwear of 0.2%. However, an increase was noted in the sub-index for Health of 1.0%. All other sections remained unchanged.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of December, 2020 had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.
