INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—January, 2021 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of January, 2021, was 109.9, representing an increase of 0.4 point or 0.4% above the All Items Index for December, 2020.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January, 2021, over the period January, 2020, was 0.9%. This rate is more than that observed for the period January 2020 over the period January, 2019, which was 0.4%.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 120.1 in December, 2020, to 120.2 in January, 2021, reflecting an increase of 0.1%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of whole chicken—fresh, carite—fresh, carrots, cucumber, tea-in-bag, potatoes, grapes, evaporated milk, powdered milk—full cream, and bodi. The full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general decreases in the prices of tomatoes, cabbage, oranges, fresh, chilled, frozen or seasoned beef, chive, fresh beef, steak—fresh beef, melongene, other fresh pork, and mixed fresh seasoning.

Price changes in this section for the month of January, 2021, had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for January, 2021, compared with December, 2020, reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 1.1%, Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels of 0.8%, Health of 0.2%, Transport of 1.3%, and Recreation and Culture of 0.3%. However, decreases were noted in the sub-indices for Clothing and Footwear of 1.0%, Communication of 0.1%, and Miscellaneous Goods and Services of 0.1%. All other sections remained unchanged.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of January, 2021, accounted for a net overall increase of 0.4 point in the All Items Index.
