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INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—February, 2021 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of February, 2021, was 109.8, representing a decrease of 0.1 point or 0.1% below the All Items Index for January, 2021.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January to February, 2021, over the period January to February, 2020 was 0.9%. This rate is greater than that observed for the period January to February, 2020, over the period January to February, 2019, which was 0.4%.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 120.2 in January, 2021, to 119.3 in February, 2021, reflecting a decrease of 0.7%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of whole chicken—fresh, tomatoes, oranges, other chilled or frozen chicken, celery, chive, fresh, chilled, frozen or seasoned beef, bodi, mixed fresh seasoning, and other fruit drinks (not orange drink). However, the full impact of these price decreases was offset by the general increase in the prices of melongene, grapes, carite—fresh, parboiled rice, garlic, cucumber, king fish—fresh, potatoes, lettuce and canned tuna.

Price changes in this section for the month of February, 2021, accounted for a net overall decrease of 0.2 point in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for February 2021, compared with January, 2021, reflected an increase in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.2% and Health of 0.1%. However a decrease was noted in the sub-index for Clothing and Footwear of 0.5%. All other sections remained unchanged.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of February, 2021, accounted for a net overall increase of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.
