INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES—March, 2021 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Index of Retail Prices is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from the prices collected for the month of March, 2021, was 109.9, representing an increase of 0.1 point or 0.1% above the All Items Index for February, 2021.

The Rate of Inflation, as measured by the percentage change in the average All Items Index for the period January to March, 2021, over the period January to March, 2020 was 0.9% which was also recorded for the previous period (January to February, 2021/January to February, 2020). This rate is greater than that observed for the period January to March, 2020, over the period January to March, 2019, which was 0.4%.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 119.3 in February, 2021, to 119.8 in March, 2021, reflecting an increase of 0.4%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of garlic, ochroes, steak—fresh beef, whole chickens—fresh, parboiled rice, macaroni, bodi, soya bean oil, salted pigtail, salmon—fresh. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decreases in the prices of tomatoes, potatoes, oranges, cabbage, melongene, melon, hot peppers, pimento, pumpkin and grapes.

Price changes in this section for the month of March, 2021, accounted for 0.1 point increase in the All Items Index.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for March 2021, compared with February, 2021, reflected an increase in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.5% and Clothing and Footwear of 0.6%.

Price changes in the Other Sections for the month of March, 2021, had a negligible effect on the All Items Index.
