ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(NATIONAL DAY OF REMEMBRANCE) ORDER, 2021

1. This Order may be cited as Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (National Day of Remembrance) Order, 2021.

2. This Order shall have effect from 6.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on Sunday 14th November, 2021. Duration

3. (1) Subject to subclause (2), a driver of a motor vehicle shall not Parking prohibited park on—

- (a) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Dundonald Street;
- (b) Queen's Park East;
- (c) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane;
- (d) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Dundonald Street;
- (e) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;
- (f) Abercromby Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (g) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (h) New Street, between Pembroke Street and Charlotte Street;
- (i) Chancery Lane; and
- (j) Jerningham Avenue, between Queen's Park East and Norfolk Street.

(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1)(c), a police officer on duty may direct—

- (i) a driver of a military vehicle;
- (ii) a specially invited guest driving a motor vehicle; or

(iii) a driver of a motor vehicle,

to park his motor vehicle on Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane.

(3) For the purposes of this clause, “driver of a military vehicle” means a person authorised to drive a motor vehicle controlled by the military forces whilst such vehicle is being used for military purposes in accordance with section 42(7) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.

4. A driver shall not drive his motor vehicle from 8.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on—

- (a) Frederick Street, between Queen’s Park West and Keate Street;
- (b) Queen’s Park West, between Queen’s Park East and Frederick Street;
- (c) Queen’s Park East, between Jerningham Avenue and Queen’s Park West;
- (d) Charlotte Street, between Queen’s Park West and Gordon Street; and
- (e) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street.

Vehicular

5. From 10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m., a driver of a motor vehicle proceeding—

- (a) north on Charlotte Street, shall turn west onto Gordon Street; and
- (b) north on Henry Street, shall turn east onto New Street or west onto Gordon Street.

Two-way
traffic around
Savannah

6. From 10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m., a driver of a motor vehicle may proceed in both directions around the Queen’s Park Savannah, between Maraval Road and Jerningham Avenue.

Two minutes
of silence

7. During the observance of the two minutes of silence from 11.00 a.m. to 11.02 a.m., police officers on duty shall bring to a standstill all vehicular traffic within the area bounded on the north by Queen’s Park West, on the south by Gordon Street, on the east partly by Queen’s Park East and partly by Charlotte Street and on the west by Chancery Lane.

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
