## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 30(1) of the Representation of the People Act, Chap. 2:01 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) that, for the purposes of an election, the President may, by Proclamation published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, direct that an electoral registration shall be conducted in the Registration Area Offices or the Temporary Registration Area Offices established in the electoral district in which such election is to be held:

And whereas it is further provided by section 30(3) of the Act that the President may, by a subsequent Proclamation published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, fix the date of the termination of an electoral registration:

And whereas by Proclamation dated the 11th day of December, 2020, it was directed that an electoral registration be conducted in the electoral district of Hollywood, as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government and Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2019, in relation to the electoral area of the Borough of Point Fortin, for the purpose of the election of a Councillor to serve on the Municipal Council of the Borough of Point Fortin and the 17th day of December, 2020, was fixed as the date of the commencement of the electoral registration:

Now, therefore, I, **PAULA-MAE WEEKES**, President as aforesaid, do hereby fix the 12th day of February, 2021, as the date of the termination of the electoral registration in the municipal electoral district of Hollywood, in the electoral area of the Borough of Point Fortin, as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government and Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2019.
