## Act No. 7 of 2022

An Act to amend the Companies Act, Chap. 81:01 to make provision for the role of the Chief State Solicitor as the Official Receiver

[Assented to 22nd April, 2022]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Companies short title (Amendment) Act, 2022.

Interpretation Chap. 81:01 2. In this Act, "the Act" means the Companies Act.

Section 4 amended

**3.** The Act is amended in section 4 by inserting after the definition of "officer", the following new definition:

""Official Receiver" means the Chief State Solicitor;".

Section 366 repealed

4. Section 366 of the Act is repealed.

Section 462 amended

**5.** Section 462 of the Act is amended by repealing subsection (4).
